## Final Oral Round

### Task 1

Give a ten-minute presentation on your school as if to an incoming group of Erasmus students of your age group and their teachers visiting your school. Introduce it from the students' perspective, including hands-on help for the guests. You may wish to speak about, for example, the school canteen, the snack bar (opening hours, prices, student satisfaction), the school library, photocopying possibilities, where the staff room is, etc. Think about introducing afternoon activities, clubs, sports activity possibilities, competitions, special calendar events and celebrations (freshman's camp, Christmas party, etc.), the school's online presence and access, charity events and volunteering, international connections, and so on. You may mention what to do and what to visit around the school. – Use this list of possible topics only as a suggestion or a source of inspiration, and feel free to include/exclude whatever you find relevant/irrelevant for such an audience of incoming Erasmus students you wish to welcome and make friends with.

Support your presentation by Powerpoint/Prezi slides. We expect you to talk freely, without reading out a continuous written text. (Notes are welcome.) Be prepared to answer a few questions about your presentation.

#### Criteria of evaluation:

- the content's relevance and information value;
- the focus being appropriate for the time limit;
- structure: title, logic, proportions, cohesion;
- timing;
- the visuals' relationship to what is said;
- fluency, loudness and intonation; style;
- accuracy.

### Task 2

Talk to another candidate about a controversial issue based on a topic offered by the competition jury. The discussion will last for five minutes.

#### Criteria of evaluation:

- content;
- interaction;
- fluency;
- grammatical accuracy;
- vocabulary;
- pronunciation.
