Mentors & Tutors	We operate a personal tutor system. Each incoming student receives a student tutor who helps both prior to and during the semester(s) with academic orientation and integration into cultural and social life.

- **Semester Division:** The academic year is divided into two semesters. The **1st Semester (Fall semester)** starts at the beginning of September, while the **2nd Semester (Spring semester)** starts at the beginning of February.

- **Classes** are held from beginning of September to mid-December, and from the beginning of February to mid-May.

Students applying to the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences are recommended to arrive one week before the semester starts for the orientation session.

At the end of each semester, students have an **exam period** for oral and/or written exams. Please note that these exams apply strictly to **lecture-type courses**.

For **seminar-type courses**, students do not need to register for an exam; instead, the final grade is based on continuous assessment, including class participation, regular assignments, and overall performance throughout the semester.

- Please bear in mind that the official **Erasmus mobility period** must cover the full academic block (including both the teaching period and the exam period). Depending on the course structure, some exams can also be taken one week before the official exam period during the pre-examination week.

- **Study levels:** The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences welcomes both **BA and MA students**. We are also happy to assist students with their thesis work during their mobility period.

- **Course Languages:** Most of our foreign language courses are taught in **English**, though we also offer courses in German, French, Spanish, and Italian.

Prospective Erasmus students are kindly asked to check the available course lists on our website 5–6 weeks before their mobility period starts. For further details, please visit:
