Should plagiarism be detected, the grade will be a ‘1’.

The three topics:

1“All books should be available free on the internet.” Do you agree?

2“Individual countries do not have the right to interfere with the affairs of another country.” Do you agree?

3 “Polygamy should be allowed by law in Europe” Do you agree?
