Task set 7. Elicitation, search for patterns.

Task set 8. More pragmatic.

Definiteness: Does Nikolaeva's claim hold in Udmurt?

In Uralic the range of possible relationships between two entities encoded by means of the possessive construction is much wider than in Indo-European, in fact infinite, therefore the possessive affixes can [express any kind of association between the host noun and another entity](#). This entity must be already established in the discourse or the situation of speech by the time of the utterance, so such constructions share one important property: the "possessor" is conceptualised first and serves as a cognitive

reference-point for establishing mental contact with the “possessed”.
